LENTERA HUKUM is a peer-reviewed journal dedicated to providing thoughtful and scholarly works with aims to explore and expand the boundaries of legal studies. Published three times a year, this platform advances the publication of scholarly works embedding with fundamental issues in law. The special emphasis in this journal is placed on a variety of contemporary development by focusing on law and its social dimensions to complement an increasingly wide range of studies in the field of law and society scholarship.

Focus and Scope

The journal invites works on contemporary legal development in empirical, socio-legal, doctrinal, and comparative studies. Articles submitted to this journal may cover topical issues, but not limited to constitutional and administrative law, corporate law, criminal justice, indigenous law, private international law, public international law, international economic law, human rights law, and intellectual property law.

Publication Frequency

This journal publishes articles three times a year in April, July, and December.

Manuscript submission

To be considered for publication in this journal, all manuscripts should be submitted into our online journal system at <https://jurnal.unej.ac.id/index.php/eJLH/submissions>. All authors can refer to author guidelines which can be accessed at <https://jurnal.unej.ac.id/index.php/eJLH/about/submissions#authorGuidelines>.

Before the submission, authors are required to ensure that manuscripts have been written well in English (US) or Bahasa (Indonesian) and the citations should conform as closely as possible to Canadian Guide to Uniform Legal Citation. Alternatively, authors are highly encouraged to use citation tools like Zotero and Mendeley that provide various citation styles to ease the manuscript's citation to be written correctly.

Due to a very high number of manuscripts submitted to this journal, we normally need at least three months prior to our decision whether manuscripts are accepted for publication or rejected from publication. However, all authors are advised to submit manuscripts earlier than three months from the regular date of publication as it is our standard by which all articles should pass rigorous reviews before the publication.

Peer Review Process

This journal will review manuscripts which should be 7,000-10,000 words (Articles), 4,000-6,000 words (Commentaries), and 1,500-2,000 words (Book Reviews). All submitted manuscripts will be pre-reviewed by editors to determine whether manuscripts have conformed to the submission guidelines of the journal. Manuscripts which have conformed to the journal's style will be peer-reviewed. This journal applies a double-blind peer-review process which involves reviewers of experts in the relevant field of legal studies. The task of reviewers is to give an assessment on originality, clarity of presentation, contribution to the field/science. The final decision of manuscript acceptance is solely decided by the editors according to reviewers' comments.

It is solely the author's responsibility to ensure that the manuscript submitted to this journal is original and plagiarism free. Plagiarism and self-plagiarism are not allowed. Editors have the right to decline the submission when it is found that the manuscript is detected with plagiarism. Detection of overlapping and similar text is used there and so quotations and appropriate citations have to be used whenever required.
